During the 2009-10 school year, your child will have several opportunities to contribute content for reports or projects to post on our classroom website *The Nettling Newsline*.

Daily News. Students will get an opportunity to take on the role of the *News Crew* reporter and write an article about what we are doing in class. I will then publish their article on *The Nettling Newsline* website. Students will bring home details about *how* to do this when it is their turn to be the reporter.



Projects. Throughout the year, students will be do projects for different topics they are studying. This provides a fun way to make connections for students to review and for parents to connect with what their child is doing in class.

With podcasting (audio files placed online for anyone to subscribe to) becoming more and more popular, students will be on the cutting edge as we create audio broadcasts highlighting what we are learning in class. At times, we might even add photos, images or video to our audio productions, resulting in "vodcasts"! I will take the recordings and put together the finished product – a broadcast that will be posted on <http://www.leslienettling.com/NettlingNewscasts.htm>. You'll even be able to download them on your Ipod (or other mp3 player)!
